- ♦ Patron mail orders must be postmarked by Friday, March 21. After this date, please call or visit the Harvard Box Office.
- ♦ A service charge applies to all credit card orders taken over the phone and online. To avoid this charge, please visit the Box Office. A \$3.50 processing fee applies to all mail orders. The Box Office cannot take unpaid reservations.
- ♦ A small number of wheelchair locations are available in the balcony; assisted listening devices are also available for those who require them. Please specify your needs when ordering tickets.
- ♦ All ticket orders processed more than 10 days prior to showtime will be mailed. Other orders will be held at the door.
